- **Membership ID provided to all paid participants for use when requesting your vacation watch.**
- Yard sign with identification for participation year provided to all paid participants.
- Comprehensive security coverage via trained, licensed, armed officers and K-9 patrols on foot and in marked cars.
- Dedicated phone line for reports from Oak Forest residents.
- Fast response via GPS tracking and command center dispatch.
- Additional community involvement includes vacation watch, home security inspection, and residential safety escort (while on duty).
